

ORDINANCE NO. O-2008-153

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE NUMBER OF CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2008 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2009; AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 3, "PERSONNEL/CIVIL SERVICE/TMRS"; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code requires the City Council to approve a Fire and Police Civil Service employee classification plan and authorize the number of employees for each position on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the number and classification of authorized positions can only be changed by City ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is considered to be in the best interests of the Police department to abolish the one Deputy Chief position and create another Assistant Chief position; and

WHEREAS, the City Code in Section 3-43 sets out the Civil Service Classification Plan subject to approving the actual number of employees in each fiscal year's annual budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That pursuant to state law (Local Government Code Section 143.021), the Police department classification plan as set out in City Code Section 3-43 is amended to read as follows, with the rest of the section remaining unchanged:

Sec. 3-43. Classification plan adopted.

The following is adopted as the classification plan for Tyler Civil Service employees.


