

**ORDINANCE NO. O-2008-129**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, APPROVING THE NUMBER OF CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2008 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2009; AND AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 3, "PERSONNEL/CIVIL SERVICE/TMRS."**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code requires the City Council to approve a Fire and Police Civil Service employee classification plan and authorize the number of employees for each position on an annual basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the number and classification of authorized positions can only be changed by City ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Code in Section 3-43 sets out the Civil Service Classification Plan subject to approving the actual number of employees in each fiscal year's annual budget;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:**

**PART 1:** That pursuant to state law (Local Government Code Section 143.021) and City Code Section 3-43, the number of employees in Fire and Police Civil Service positions for fiscal year 2008-2009 shall be as follows:

**Sec. 3-43. Classification plan adopted.**

The following is adopted as the classification plan for Tyler Civil Service employees.

The number and base salary of positions allocated to each classification shall be as set by the City Council in each new fiscal year budget, and classification ordinance.\*

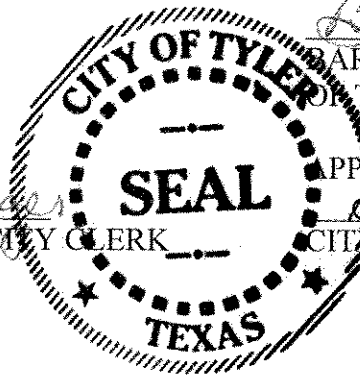
