

**ORDINANCE NO. 0-2009-116**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AMENDING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) 2007 ANNUAL PLAN AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, for many years, the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has allocated funds through grant applications to the City of Tyler for neighborhood improvement programs, along with administrative costs associated with such programs; and

**WHEREAS**, each year, the City of Tyler needs to re-appropriate and reprogram budgets in order to expedite an effective and timely Community Development Block Grant and HOME Programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Tyler is revising its 2007 Annual Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:**

**PART 1:** That the proposed amendments are hereby approved, subject to approval and allocation by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

**PART 2:** That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to submit the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) 2007 Annual Plan as attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**PART 3:** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
