

ORDINANCE NO. O-2009-54

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009 AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$127,575 IN DEFERRED HFC REVENUE FUNDS FOR EXPENDITURE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2007, the City Council approved the purchase of the old Regions Bank building on Gentry Parkway as the new location for the City of Tyler Neighborhood Services Department; and

WHEREAS, it was anticipated that the draperies that were in the building prior to renovation could be salvaged; and

WHEREAS, due to age, wear and tear, and mildew, they had to be discarded and bids were solicited from several businesses to make and hang drapes for all of the outer windows;

WHEREAS, funding for this purchase is available from the deferred revenue account 285-0000-220-000, which currently has a \$127,575 balance that has not yet been appropriated for the current year;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following line item accounts as approved in the budget for fiscal year 2008-2009 shall be amended to read as follows:

PART 2: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of this budget amendment as required by law.

PART 3: That amendment of the fiscal year 2008-2009 Budget at this time is required in order to provide funding for draperies for the old Regions Bank building on Gentry Parkway which is now the new location for the City of Tyler Neighborhood Services Department, which creates an urgent public necessity to authorize the amendment to the budget herein contained.

PART 4: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
