

ORDINANCE NO. 0-2010-50

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR RENOVATIONS OF CITY HALL.

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2007 the City Council adopted the Tyler 21 Plan that included an action to “renovate the interior of City Hall Space and review space needs for city government”; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized execution of a design contract with Fitzpatrick Butler Architects, Incorporated to draw up plans/specifications and take bids for renovation of City Hall; and

WHEREAS, with the construction of planned renovations, City Hall will benefit from the new elevator and restoration of existing restrooms;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following line item accounts as approved in the budget for fiscal year 2009-2010 shall be amended to read as follows:

PART 2: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of this budget amendment as required by state law.

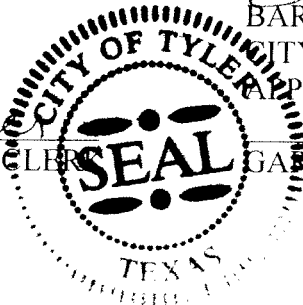
