

RESOLUTION NO. R-2009-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE TYLER POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE OF TEXAS FROM THE EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE SHARED POLICE EMERGENCY ARMORED RESCUE (SPEAR) VEHICLE PROJECT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Tyler and the surrounding region that the Shared Police Emergency Armored Rescue (SPEAR) vehicle project be operated for the 2009-2010 grant year; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council of the City of Tyler assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas designates the City Manager of the City of Tyler as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1. That the submission of the grant application for the Shared Police Emergency Armored Rescue (SPEAR) vehicle project for the 2009/2010 grant year to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division is approved.

PART 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
