

RESOLUTION NO. R-2010-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, CONFIRMING SUPPORT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF LOOP 323 AND CHARLOTTE DRIVE/SILVER CREEK DRIVE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to protect the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, it is considered to be in the public interest to expedite the construction of a traffic control signal at the intersection of Loop 323 and Charlotte Drive/Silver Creek Drive; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City of Tyler pledges to contribute 100% of the funding for construction costs of the traffic control signal located at the intersection of Loop 323 and Charlotte Drive/Silver Creek Drive.

PART 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Local Project Advanced Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for construction of the traffic signal.

PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

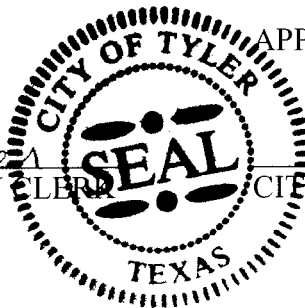
