

RESOLUTION NO. R-2010-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE TYLER POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE OF TEXAS FROM THE EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT TO ALLOW THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ENROLL IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT ANALYSIS PORTAL (LEAP) PROGRAM TO SHARE LAW ENFORCEMENT RELATED INFORMATION WITH THE SURROUNDING REGIONAL AGENCIES AND TO ENHANCE THE INVESTIGATIVE ABILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT BY ADDING ADDITIONAL LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas find it in the best interest of the citizens of Tyler and the surrounding region that the City of Tyler Police Department be permitted apply for grant funding to enroll in the LEAP information sharing program and to procure additional License Plate Recognition equipment that will increase the effectiveness and efficiency of the Police Department crime prevention and investigation efforts for the 2010-2011 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council of the City of Tyler assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and


WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tyler, Texas designates the City Manager of the City of Tyler as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the submission of the grant application to the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, via the East Texas Council of Government, as part of the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant program for the enrollment subscriptions to the LEAP information sharing program and to purchase additional license plate recognition equipment for the 2010/2011 grant year is hereby approved.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
