TOURS

Mondays and Fridays between 10 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays between noon and 2:30 p.m.

Approximately 90 minutes

Maximum of three classes per visit.

When multiple classes visit, the students will round-robin through three units: tour, storytelling and free time in the children's book section.

Program includes:

- Opportunity for students to obtain a Tyler Public Library card.
 - Applications and instructions sent in advance to teachers for dissemination to families.
 - Applications must be turned in to Library one week prior to visit.
- Walking tour of all three floors of the Tyler Public Library - including children's and adult fiction and non-fiction sections, reference area, audio visual department and local and family history room.
- Age-appropriate games/instruction in basic library skills.
- Interactive session with experienced storyteller.
 - Head Start–Grade 2 –age-appropriate books and stories.
 - Grades 3-5 –award-winning books and class-created fractured fairy tale.
 - Grades 6-8 –award-winning books and class story OR reference and research skills.

Tours can be designed to meet special needs of students or teachers at any level. Adult tours are also available.
