point and shoot camera and want to learn to take more intimate photos than ever before or have a digital SLR and want to learn new techniques to take your photography to the next level, these sessions are for you.

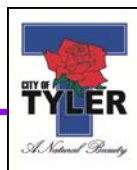
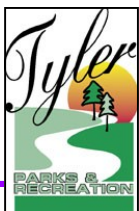
