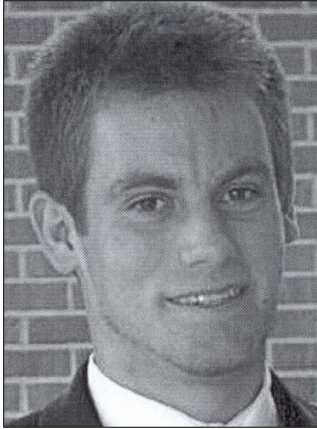


# Mark Randall Davis

**Date Missing: January 15, 2007**



Tyler-Smith County Crimestoppers needs your help in locating Mark Davis.

Davis was last seen around sunrise on Monday, January 15, 2007, riding his mountain bicycle near Paluxy Drive, South Broadway, Cumberland Road and Loop 49 in south Tyler. He was wearing jeans, tennis shoes, and a black or maroon jacket and could also be wearing a black hood or ski toboggan. Davis can be described as a 20-year old white male, 5'8", medium build, brown hair and brown eyes.

The mountain bicycle has metallic forest green grips on the handle bar along with "Expedition Specialized" on the frame. Davis was later possibly seen two days later around 8:15 a.m. on Wednesday, January 17<sup>th</sup>, going north on County Road 137 in Flint. The bike may have been abandoned in a wooded area or at some remote location.

Davis is a Texas A&M Senior majoring in Spanish. He should have returned to school on Monday, January 15<sup>th</sup>.
