

Garbage containers must be at the curb by 7 a.m. on your pickup day and removed from the curb by 7 a.m. the day following collection.

Household garbage collection days are:
Mondays and Thursdays or Tuesdays and Fridays.

Yard waste includes small brush in containers; limbs four feet or less in length, tied in bundles; dry leaves and grass placed in biodegradable bags or waterproof containers (not to exceed 50 pounds per container); or miscellaneous garbage. Yard waste is collected on the same day as household garbage, as space and time allows. These items should be placed at the curb **six feet** away from your garbage cart.

Special pickups are available for bulky items, large limbs or unbundled brush for a fee. **For estimates, email solidwaste@tylertexas.com or call the office.**

Carts are for household garbage only. Please do not place yard waste in the cart. Place your cart behind the curb or street line with the lid opening to the street. Your cart must be **six feet** away from any stationary objects such as mailboxes, utility poles or vehicles. These carts are designed to be picked up by an automated truck, which must have clear access to the cart from the street. The carts are assigned to your address, so if you move, leave the cart. Please do not put trash bags or boxes on top of the cart lid. Place them **six feet away from your garbage cart.** Containers can be placed at the curb no earlier than 6 p.m. the day before collection and must be removed from the curb by 7 a.m. the day following collection.

Tires - four (4) non-commercial tires will be picked up free of charge (no tractor or semi-truck tires). Tires should be placed at the curb and will be picked up during the week. Larger tires can be dropped off at the Recycling Center for a fee.

Paint should be completely dried with kitty litter or oil dry and placed on the curb **six feet** from your garbage cart with the lid off.

Deceased animals - The Solid Waste Department will not pick up dead animals. Please call Animal Control at (903) 535-0045 or (903) 531-1000 (if after hours).

Bagged Leaves— 25 or more bags require a special pick up. For an estimate, call (903) 531-1388.

Spring and Fall Cleanup

Free Bulky Item Collection is held twice yearly, once in the spring and once in the fall. Residential customers may get rid of bulky items such as unwanted furniture, appliances, carpet, fence material, up to four non-commercial vehicle tires, old toys and other large items that would normally require a special fee. **Brush is not included.** Visit www.TylerSolidWaste.com for updates.




Keep Tyler Beautiful

Tyler Recycling Collection Center



The Recycling Center is a great way to reduce the amount of waste at the Landfill.

The self-service drop-off center located at **418 N. Bois D'Arc Ave.** is available to everyone.

The Recycling Center accepts the following items:

- Paper (newspapers, magazines, phonebooks, ads and office paper)
- Cardboard of any type (broken down)
- Plastic (rinsed and crushed #1 and #2, lids removed; examples-water or soda bottles, milk jugs and detergent bottles)
- Glass (rinsed clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars with lids removed)
NO BLUE GLASS or MIRRORS
- Ink cartridges
- Electronics (computers, TVs, monitors, cell phones, chargers and other portable devices)
- Metal (copper, aluminum, brass and steel)
- Aluminum cans (rinsed and crushed, no aluminum pie plates or tin)
- Household appliances (refrigerated appliances may require a disposal fee)
- Motor oil/hydraulic fluid /Anti-freeze
- Automotive batteries

Curbside Recycling



Curbside Recycling is available for Tyler residential customers. This optional service provides every other week curbside recycling collection and a separate recycling cart.



All items must fit inside the cart. You can request an additional cart.

Break down and crush cardboard, plastic and cans to make items fit inside the cart. A second cart is required for items outside the cart. **For safety reasons, glass is not accepted** in the curbside program, however glass can be dropped off at the Recycling Center.

Items available for collection:

- Aluminum cans (rinsed and crushed, no aluminum pie plates)
- Plastic (rinsed and crushed #1 and #2, lids removed; examples-water or soda bottles, milk jugs and detergent bottles, look for the number inside the recycling triangle on the bottom of the container)
- Tin cans (rinsed)
- Cardboard (broken down)
- Paper (newspapers, magazines, ads and office paper)
- Junk mail
- Brown paper grocery bags



Commercial Garbage Collection



Tyler Solid Waste offers: 96 gallon hand pickup service for small businesses; front load dumpsters with two, three, four, six or eight cubic yard capacities with one to six times per week collection; open-top, roll-off containers in 12, 20, 30 or 40 cubic yard capacities and compactors. We also offer special pickup collections for large debris removal.

Litter Critters



Residents who have been at their address at least three months may rent an eight-yard Litter Critter up to two times per year for small home projects. It may be rented from Friday afternoon until

Monday morning, or from Monday afternoon until Friday morning. This service can be pre-paid or charged to your water bill. A release must be signed before delivery. Containers are placed in the driveway. This container is not for commercial use. No appliances, tires, liquids, paint, pesticides, chemicals or other hazardous waste are allowed.

Greenwood Farms Landfill



Greenwood Farms Landfill is owned by the City of Tyler and operated by Republic Services.

Tyler Solid Waste residential customers may deposit a three cubic yard load of garbage (the size of a level pickup truck bed) per month at the Landfill by presenting the top portion of their current City of Tyler water utility bill and a valid driver's license matching the water bill address. Additional deposits of refuse are charged at the posted gate rate. The person whose name is on the utility bill must be present.

Appliances and tires are not included and have special pricing at the Landfill and the Tyler Recycling Collection Center.

State law requires loads of garbage to be covered during trips to the Landfill. If a load is not covered, a \$25 surcharge will be assessed by the Landfill. Canvas tarps or heavy plastic covers can be used to hold the refuse in the vehicle to prevent debris from falling out and littering the roadside.

The Landfill is located at 12920 FM 2767 (Old Kilgore Highway), five miles east of Loop 323. The Landfill is closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. Call (903) 566-5007 for details.
