PARK HOURS

All city parks except Children's Park, Bergfeld Park, and Hillside Park are open between the hours of 6 a.m. and 10 a.m.

Bergfeld Park is open between sunrise and sunset, with the exception of the lighted tennis court area; Hillside Park is open from sunrise to sunset. Exceptions may apply when activities sponsored or sanctioned by the City Parks Department are in progress and for thirty minutes after the conclusion of such activities. It is unlawful to enter a park or remain in a park during hours when a park is closed.

RESERVATIONS

The amphitheater, pavilions and spray ground may be rented for your next birthday party, family reunion or special event. To make a reservation, please complete a Special Events Permit Application and submit it to the Parks and Recreation office along with the permit fee. The forms are available at the Parks offices located at 2000 W. Front Street inside Harvey Convention Center, on the web at www.TylerParksandRec.com or we would be happy to email the form to you upon request.

Pavilions and the amphitheater are available for an additional rental fee.

Events which are open to the public also require proof of general liability insurance listing the City of Tyler as additional insured.

The parks system features playgrounds, athletic fields, walking trails, an amphitheater, tennis courts, multi-purpose courts and so much more.


We hope you and your family enjoy the amazing quality of life amenities that the Parks and Recreation Department has to offer.




MISSION

To provide our citizens with attractive outdoor spaces that are well maintained while continuing to be fiscally responsible.








